This notice is provided because of the filing of an application for permanent alien labor certification for the following tenure-track position: Assistant Professor of Philosophy.

The following is a statement of the job duties and requirements:

Teach introductory and advanced level philosophy courses at the undergraduate level, including some courses in non-European Philosophy. Teach interdisciplinary first-year seminars on rotation. Demonstrate a standard of high-quality in teaching, including the following: Advise and mentor students, including fair assessment of student class work, assignments, and papers; Develop and demonstrate expertise (range and depth) in areas of teaching competency; Plan, evaluate, and revise curricula, course content, and course materials and methods of instruction; Foster student learning. Actively engage the discipline of philosophy through scholarship and research activities and publications. Provide service to the community at the departmental and college level as appropriate to faculty rank. Fulfill other academic responsibilities as appropriate. The expected teaching load is currently five classes each academic year. Position is F/T, M-F.

Must have a Ph.D. degree or its foreign equivalent in Philosophy or ABD.
