SGA President Lowell said that ExComm met last week. The meeting was chaired by EVP Jansen, and the Committee talked about SGA leadership awards. Recipients were picked and shared with the Office of Leadership Activities. Interim Academic Council Chair Lowell shared that the Academic Council will meet tomorrow. VPFA Maxwell reported that B&F met for 6 hours on Sunday for their final budget review session. They met again yesterday and finalized the draft for the 2024-2025 operating budget. VPSL Flamenbaum talked about attending an SGA conference at Colgate with S. Kadets and there are hopes of collaborating with more peer institution SGAs in the future. He said that there will be more water fountains on campus next year, and a fountain near the cereal station in the dining hall should be installed soon. Finally, he reported that laundry posters and CSL info posters will go into residence halls soon. VPCA Pienkowski said that the CAC met on Monday and reviewed the charter application for the

Skidmore Student Chamber Choir. The charter was denied on the basis of the club originally not being audition based, but then switching to have an audition process. VPIO Alvarez said that CIO met last Thursday and hosted an open forum about gender identity in the classroom. The results of such will move forward with the AC. SCP Grijalva said that midnight dodgeball will happen on Friday and that the prior week schedule will be available tomorrow.
